He is also the only physiatrist in the group who performs facet rhizotomy procedures.

He went on to again graduate at the top of his medical school class at the University of Illinois Chicago, where he was awarded the Grove "Outstanding Graduate" Award and inducted into the AOA Medical Honor Society. Dr. Revord completed a fellowship at the National Institute of Health, before attending the world-renowned Mayo Clinic Graduate School of Medicine for residency, where he specialized in Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation.
